



# GUIDELINES FOR TRANSPORTING YOUNG PLAYERS



This policy lays down Ashley CC approach to travel arrangements for cricket matches. Generally our approach means that parents are responsible for transportation to and from games and practice sessions.

## **Away Fixtures**

- The team managers of the respective teams will inform parents/carer's of the date, venue, arrival time and finish time of the game
- It is the parent or carer's responsibility to make the necessary arrangements for their child to get to the venue for the stated time, either by transporting their own child or making arrangements with other parents
- It is the parent or carer's responsibility to make the necessary arrangements for their child to be returned from the venue to home by, transporting their own child or making arrangements with other parents
- The respective team manager will undertake to check at the end of a game that all children have been collected. In the event of arrangements breaking down, the team manager will attempt to contact the parent/carer's and agree a new arrangement
- Should the team manager be unable to make any contact they will take responsibility for ensuring that the child is returned
- Any transport provided by club officials will be in "exceptional circumstances" and deemed to be "with parental consent" and "without liability"

## **Home Fixtures & Practice Sessions**

- It is the parent or carer's responsibility to make the necessary arrangements for their child to get to the venue for the stated time, either by transporting their own child or making arrangements with other parents.
- It is the parent or carer's responsibility to make the necessary arrangements for their child to be returned from the venue to home by, transporting their own child or making arrangements with other parents.
- The respective team manager will undertake to check at the end of a game/practice session that all children have been collected. In the event of arrangements breaking down, the team manager will attempt to contact the parent/carer and agree a new arrangement.
- Should the team manager be unable to make any contact they will stay at the venue with the child until contact is made with the parent or carer. The team manager will try and ensure that other children or preferably adults are also at the venue until new arrangements are sorted and carried out.
